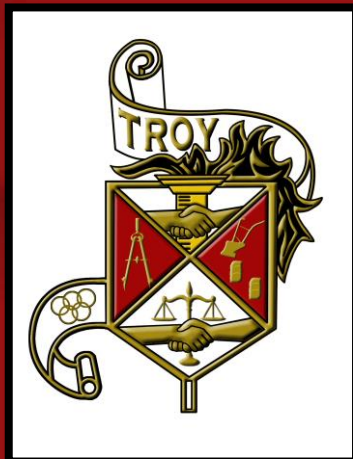


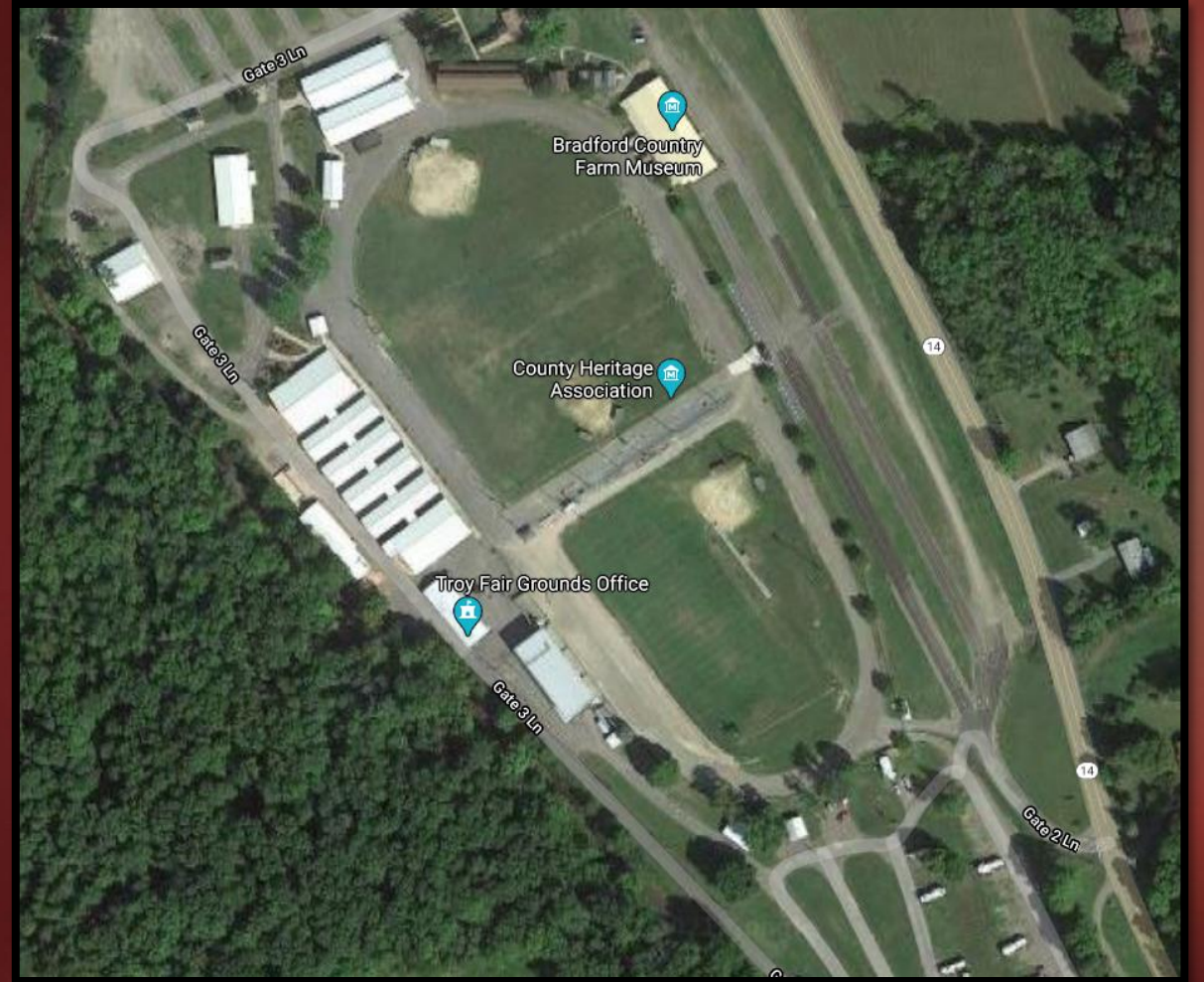
SENIOR EVENT SUMMARY



Class of 2021

GRADUATION – 6/11 8PM

- Maintain tradition, accommodate for COVID, make great.
- Students will be provided an option to have graduation at:
 - The HS Student lot, with graduates on the hill, and families in the lot.
 - Capacity for guests (parking spaces): 932 (50 percent of 67 people /1000 sq foot)
 - Benefits: Preferred aesthetic, no fee to the district
 - Concerns: sound system, lighting, parking availability, setup and teardown, restroom availability.
 - Alparon Park with students on the field and families in the grandstand:
 - Capacity for guests: 1400 (½ of the regular venue capacity)
 - Benefits: Sound System in place, lighting in place, increased capacity, parking for students (parade), and parking for families, limited cover for weather
 - Concerns: Less preferable aesthetic, cost \$500 THS set up, \$1000 Alparon set up



GRADUATION PARADE

- The parade will occur starting at 6pm, prior to graduation.
 - This will be a parade like last year and will end in the location of the graduation ceremony.



SENIOR DAY TRIP

- Date: June 4, 2021
- Ms. Herman and Mr. Williams are working with the students to determine details.
 - A student survey has been administered by the senior class to determine interest in various venues.
 - Options include Hershey, Darian Lake, whitewater rafting, paintball, or an outdoor park that has multiple activities.



AWARDS CEREMONY

- Date: Tuesday June 7 at 6:30pm
- Mrs. Brown and Mrs. Houseknecht are working on this event. This is expected to be a one-day event and will take place in the Gymnasium.
- The capacity will be 165 ($1100 \cdot .15$) including about 40 students receiving awards and 10 adults administering the program.
- This allows 40 students and 115 guests
 - Each student will get two tickets and can request additional.
 - Would like to livestream as well so other community members and coaches are able to watch.



PROM

- Date: May 29, 2021 7pm to 10:30pm
- Prom will be held in the gym to accommodate 165 in total attendance.
- Tickets are \$20 a piece and offered to THS students first and then guests.
- Masks will be mandatory for everyone in attendance.
