Dear Troy Intermediate School:

We are transitioning to an alternative method of instructional delivery starting tomorrow September 29, 2020. We plan to continue this until October 19, 2020. The following details will tell you how we will proceed with this form of education.

- Students who have internet access will log in daily to see the lesson and to have communication with their teacher if necessary.
- Students who do not have adequate internet access will need to complete assignments by the end of the week to assure they get credit for their attendance. We are working on installing outdoor hotspots at all the buildings (HS, TIS, and WRC) for parents and students to use that may not have adequate internet.

Your child's teacher will be in contact with you regarding zoom times and classroom procedures. Teachers will be posting explanations and directions on CAOLA, our online learning platform, for your children to complete. The Zoom times are scheduled, but students can work on their assignments throughout the day at convenient times.

The expectation is that the students will complete their work and that will give them their attendance for the day. If you have any difficulties, please contact your teacher or the administration of your building.

For families that are having technology issues, please first contact the student's teacher, and if it does not get resolved, then contact the TIS office at 570-297-4565.

Parent Teacher Conferences will be conducted exclusively through Zoom and phone calls on October 12th from 10:30-6:00.
