- Replacing interactive smart boards that are outdated and worn out
- Incorporating an 8-period day at the HS to provide more course opportunities for students

- Increasing STEM opportunities at the HS and the Intermediate School
- The principals along with Mr. Schrader, Mrs. Caudill and Mr. Palmer are working on ways to use the C & N grant money to support STEM opportunities
- ▶ Incorporating Career Pathways at the HS in Business, STEM, & Health Science
- Working with Dave Morgan from Immaculata University regarding a \$35,000.00 dollar grant to support STEM in our district
- Looking into developing a partnership with Immaculata University regarding an Arts program to support us with providing more cultural assemblies for our students

How are we supporting advancing students?

- Supporting AP courses that will provide students with the opportunity to receive college credits
- Supporting partnerships with local universities for students to earn college credit
- Supporting partnerships with local businesses/organizations to provide job training experiences for our students
- Providing advanced online course opportunities for students
- Seeking and investigating the possibility of our students helping to complete parts of the concession stand at the track
- Looking at putting together a student committee that will meet with me quarterly to discuss ways to improve the district from a student perspective
