The Granddaddy of Them All; Worcester Central School

This excerpt appeared in Upstate Life Oct/Nov, 2012 P. 20:

"Norma Alexander Ralph, Class of 1956, says that with the exception of only four times [5 now], due to world wars and the Great Depression, Worcester has had an annual Alumni Banquet since 1891. The first was actually a picnic held at Caryl's Lake, comprised of the first three graduating classes, where the alumni association was formed. Banquets in recent years have included history, skits, and there is always a roll call of participants. So everyone can know who is there and the year they represent."
