We hope you enjoy this handbook.



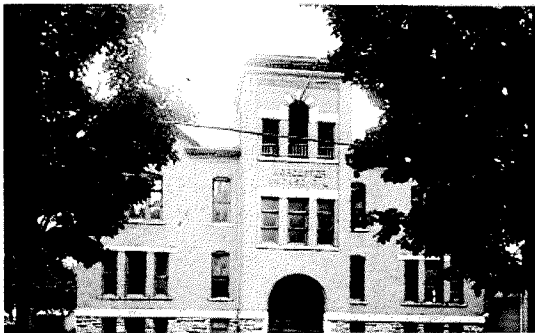
Picture of school dist no. 6

WORCESTER HIGH SCHOOL

Worcester High School began in 1889 following several other school buildings. The first graduate was Myrta Goodenough and the graduation services were held in the building now known as Nelson's Garage.

A picnic was held at Caryl's Lake in 1891 and it comprised of the first three graduating classes. At this picnic the first permanent Alumni Association was formed. The thought uppermost in the minds of the organizers was "to influence the graduates, to maintain an interest in the welfare and prosperity of the High School; to secure unity of action; pleasant cooperation among the members; that by associated efforts they may each hold a reunion in honor the graduating class."

This thought continued with graduations held from 1910-1932 in the Wieting Opera House. The Alumni continued in the new brick buildings, 1893 and 1932, to the present day, now called Worcester Central School.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF WORCESTER CENTRAL SCHOOL

The class of '91 of WHS, influenced by Prof. Calvin T. Northup, organizes the Alumni Association, August the twelfth of the same year at Caryl's Lake. There were eight charter members consisting of three graduation classes.

ART. I. OBJECT.

- (1.) The object of the Alumni Association shall be to influence the graduates of WHS to maintain an interest in her welfare and prosperity.
- (2.) To secure unity of action and pleasant co-operation among the Alumni that by associated effort we may each year hold a reunion in honor of the graduating class.

ART. II. MEMBERSHIP

- (1.) The graduating class shall be voted into the Association each year.
- (2.) Those desirous of becoming members shall hand their monies to the Secretary after the June election.
- (3.) Each member shall pay a yearly fee of sixty cents (60c.)

ART. III. OFFICERS

- (1.) We shall have a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer.

ART. IV. DUTIES

DUTIES OF PRESIDENT

- (1.) The President shall call all meetings and preside.
- (2.) Shall appoint committees.
- (3.) May propose measures but cannot vote except in case of a tie.

DUTIES OF VICE-PRESIDENT

- (1.) Shall assume the duties of President in the absence of that functionary.
- (2.) Shall act as chairman of the executive committee.

DUTIES OF SECRETARY

- (1.) Shall keep a faithful record of all meetings.
- (2.) Shall inform absent members when fees are due.

DUTIES OF TREASURER

- (1.) Shall keep account of all moneys.
- (2.) Shall pay out all moneys under order of the President.
- (3.) Shall collect dues from resident members.

ART. V. QUORUM

- (1.) The number to transact business shall be five.
- (2.) Two-thirds vote shall carry a measure.

BY-LAWS

- (1.) The secretary shall inform absent members of any changes made.
- (2.) Dues shall be paid in full by the first day in May.
- (3.) After the executive committee is appointed, meetings are held at the call of the Vice-President, who is chairman.
- (4.) Officers may be changed every year—at the annual meeting in June.
- (5.) Election shall occur the day after Commencement; or if a reception or banquet is given, the day following the same.
- (6.) There shall be:
 - Executive Committee
 - Reception Committee
 - Decorative Committee
 - Committee on Arrangements

This Constitution and the By-Laws shall date from May, 1902.

They may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members, providing a quorum is present.

AMENDMENTS TO ART. II

- (1.) The amount of fee may be changed at any time if desired.
- (2.) Any member in arrears for his dues from March 1902, may remain in the Association by paying up his back dues.
- (3.) Any member residing out of town, in arrears for his dues for four years may remain in the Association by paying one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50).
- (4.) Any member residing out of town, in arrears for his dues for a longer period than four years may remain in the Association by paying two dollars (\$2.00).

AMENDMENT TO ART III.

The offices of the Secretary and Treasurer may be in the hands of one person.

EAST WORCESTER SCHOOL

District #3

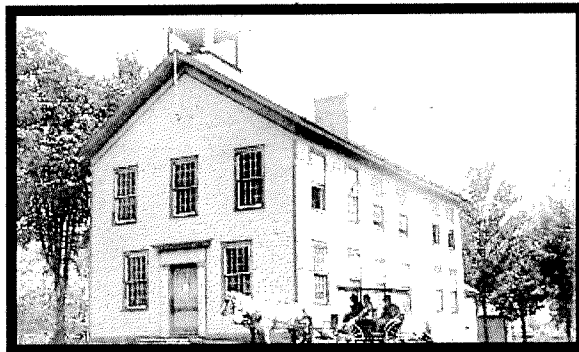
The East Worcester School began sometime before 1830 at the four corners (now Route 7 and North Road). Pictured below is a school built in 1867-1868 which was east of the last brick school building. (Now Charles Herzog Supply)

Pupils who finished the elementary grades in the one room school houses in the surrounding areas, came to the East Worcester Union School to finish and graduate. Graduations were held from 1900 through 1939.

In 1939 East Worcester consolidated with Worcester and the six upper grades came to Worcester and the elementary remained in East Worcester. This school closed in 1958.

In 1935 an alumni was formed and the first banquet was held in the Amusement Hall. Frances Dedek (Penska) was elected its first president.

The Worcester Alumni Association invited the East Worcester school graduates to become members of the WCS Association in 1965.
