NMS participated in the "Fill the Bus" campaign this October by donating canned goods and non-perishable items to support the Emergency Assistance Center.

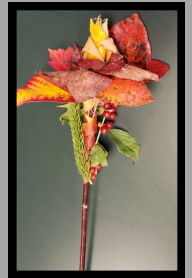
NMS collected a total of **1434** items!
