Optional: Test Scores

Test scores are not required for Admission to the college; however, they can be useful for advising purposes. Therefore, we encourage students who have taken the ACT or SAT within the past two years to request that their scores be included on their high school transcript or sent from the testing service. Our school code for the ACT is 5570 and SAT is 1984.


- You will receive an Access Code email containing your MyCState username and student ID number (sent to the email you provided when you applied)

- □ Log into MyCState and setup your SurgeMail email. All future college information will be sent to you via your SurgeMail email account.

Financial Aid

- Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) – go to www.fafsa.gov or MyStudentAid App – Cincinnati State School Code is 010345
- Check your status at MyCState go to Financial Aid and click on My Financial Aid Documents.
- □ Complete missing documents if necessary.
- Once your financial aid file is complete, watch for email notification. Your financial aid awards are listed on MyCState – go to Financial Aid and click on My Award.

Advising, Orientation & Registration

- Your letter of Admission will be sent to your mailing address and email with instructions regarding scheduling your advising appointment.
- Complete your New Student Orientation within your MyCState Account.
- $\hfill\square$ Meet with your pathway advisor and register for classes.
