

Dear Four County Parents and Students:

As soon as Governor DeWine announced that school buildings would be closed through May 1, the Four County team finalized a plan that had been made in anticipation of this decision. The updated plan, outlined below, will start beginning Monday, April 13.

- Starting April 13, 2020 assignments given to students will be mandatory to complete.
- 3rd Quarter Grades will remain the same. 4th Quarter and 2nd Semester grades will be converted to Pass or Fail.
- Each instructor is to provide each student 1-3 quality assignments per week.
- The assignments provided by each instructor should:
 - > Be between 2-3 hours maximum of quality work per week, per student.
 - > Not include any tests or quizzes.
- Any student enrolled in a Credit Recovery Class must continue to work on and complete the class.
- Also, please make sure students are emailing and/or responding to their teachers. This is very important!

We are aware that for many students this is their first experience with long-term, online instruction. Our staff will be flexible and understanding through this process and do everything possible to help students succeed.
