At approximately 2:45 pm on Thursday, March 12, Governor DeWine issued an order for all K-12 schools in Ohio to close for at least three weeks. The following are the basics of the plan that is in place for Four County:

- Students should take all needed belongings home, including their Chromebook, and/or devices. Please remember to take chargers as well.
- All of the guidelines from the Governor and the Ohio Department of Education are still not out. Once more clear guidance is available, I will contact you via email and phone with more details. Also, please check our website for updates.
