



Dear Four County Parents and Students:

Governor DeWine announced that school buildings will now be closed through May 1, 2020. While this provides some challenges, our Administrative Team and staff have actually been preparing for this possibility. I want you to rest assured that Four County Staff will work very hard to make sure our students will continue to be educated. Please review the following important points for both parents and students.

- For Seniors, schools are able to grant a diploma to any student who, at the time school closures began on March 17, was on track to graduate this spring. *However, it does not mean they are done for the year!* Seniors must keep completing all assignments and any other requirements given by instructors in all classes.
- Seniors that have credit recovery to finish must complete any credit recovery that has been assigned.
- For all students, please make every effort to do the activities that have been assigned through April 3.
- ***Also, please make sure students are emailing and/or responding to their teachers. This is very important.***
- As we finalize adjusting our educational plan for the new deadline, I will communicate all changes as soon as possible.
