## Four County Career Center On-The-Job Building Information - Procedures

- 1. The Building Request Form should be on file in the office of the Trade and Industry Supervisor by April 1<sup>st</sup> to be considered for the following school year.
- 2. A set of building plans shall accompany the Building Request form. A maximum size of 1800 square ft. of living area will be allowed unless approved in advance by the selection committee.
- 3. No major changes will be made after the plan has been submitted and approved by the selection committee.
- 4. All permits, plans, the building site, and the building materials are the responsibility of the person making the building request.
- 5. The building costs to be paid to Four County JVS at the present time are \$6.00 per trip and a gasoline transportation charge of \$2.00 per mile, plus \$1.00 per square foot of living space; \$.25 square foot of garage space, plus \$5.00 per linear foot of cabinet (base or wall) to Four County Career Center by way of reimbursement for the use of tools, equipment, and a reimbursement for transportation expense in connection with said project. The billing of these charges shall be made at two times for contracts entered into after July 1, 1982. the billing time shall be after December 31 for all charges incurred from the inception of the project through December 31, and after the project is completed for the balance of the charges on the project. Four county Career Center will require a \$1000.00 non-refundable deposit prior to construction in August which will be applied against the final billing.
- 6. A telephone needs to be available at the building site prior to the start of construction.
- 7. An insurance policy with \$100,000, Liability Coverage and "ALL RISK BUILDERS RISK" policy must be in effect during the construction period.
- 8. The Four County Career Center Building Program expects to use 9 months from September to May, to complete the building project.
- 9. Four County Career Center expects to hold an Open House during the month of May.
- 10. Four County Career Center students will be available to work on school days only, not during school or summer vacation.
- 11. The cost of the building construction project shall be borne entirely by the person making the building request.
- 12. Four County Career Center will require a \$1000.00 deposit prior to construction in August which will be applied against the final billing.
