Eligibility

To be considered for the Boettcher Scholarship, you must meet these minimum requirements:

- » Be a graduating Colorado high school senior who has lived in Colorado for your full junior and senior years;
- » Graduate from a Colorado high school; and
- » Be a citizen, legal permanent resident, or lawfully present (including through Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) in the United States

OR

» Meet the requirements and have applied or started the process of applying for citizenship, legal status, or lawful presence. (Students can be in the application process for citizenship, legal status, or lawful presence during the selection timeframe. In order to become a Scholar, you must provide documentation that shows you have completed the process successfully.)
