

Purpose: <u>To recognize and reward up to 2 Troy H. S. graduating seniors for outstanding</u>

volunteer service within our local communities.

Criteria: To be eligible for this award the applicant must

 Accumulate (grades 9-12) a minimum of 100 hours of volunteer service for which the student has received no personal gain (payment) or school credit. Non-profit volunteer or service organizations may include 4-H, Boy Scouts, Girls Scouts, fire departments, churches, Rotary, Lions, VFW/American Legion and others. Volunteering for hospitals, personal care or nursing homes, local food pantries, etc. as well as service to individual persons or families in need and other community projects are acceptable.

 Please read and complete the attached form*. Information asked for on this form which includes descriptions of your community service activities.

On a separate piece of paper, please type or legibly handwrite a paragraph in blue or black ink explaining why volunteer service is important to you and to a community.

Please limit your paragraph to approximately 150 words.

3. The signature of the Supervisor of the service activity is required and indicates verification of service completed.

4. Completed form must be returned to the Troy High School Guidance Office no later than FRIDAY, MAY 12th .

No incomplete or late forms will be considered. If there are any questions about eligibility please contact the High School Guidance Office.

Selection: Each application will be assigned a number. Students' names will be withheld so that applications may be judged anonymously by a committee of Rotarians after

reading through them all.
