**\* UNITY DAY- Wednesday, October 19<sup>th</sup> (Wear Orange to show that we are United Against Bullying)**

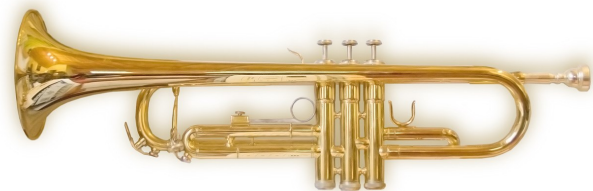
**\*Red Ribbon Week- October 24-28**

Reading a good book is like a breath of fresh air.

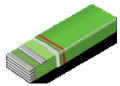
### Q-TIP
